

With the colder weather approaching and the days getting shorter, it is more important than ever to make sure your street numbers are clearly visible either on the house or at the end of your driveway. This will ensure that in the case of an emergency, public safety personnel will be able to find your home in a timely manner. Below is the town by-law governing street numbering:

Pursuant to the Hamilton Town By-Laws, Chapter XII, Section 9 states that "All principal buildings or establishments now existing or hereafter erected to which a number has been assigned shall have the number conspicuously placed in such a manner that it will be visible from the street, using figures at least three inches in height. Whenever a building stands back more than seventy-five (75) feet from the street line, the number shall be conspicuously placed at or near the street upon a post, or in some appropriate manner and location so as to be easily legible from the street."
